We shouldn't be alarmed by this, nor talk it up as a big issue in the local community, but I'm sure that our concern should be to work with the police to deter such behaviour, before it becomes more serious and of long-lasting damage to our young people, so please be aware if you're passing that way - especially over the long summer holidays.
