Corona virus advice: As in previous outbreaks of new viruses, official health advice has been given to the Church of England regarding Holy Communion. We invite everyone's cooperation in following these protocols at St Mary's:

- The president and person administering the wafers at a communion service will be using alcohol hand gel before administration.
 - People with coughs and colds should refrain from shaking hands at the peace or receiving from the common cup.
- Intinction (dipping the wafers into the cup) is **discouraged.**<u>This presents a far greater risk of spreading infection than does sharing</u> the common cup.
 - People who do not wish to drink from the common cup should receive the bread only.
- No advice has been issued to suggest that the use of the common cup should be suspended.
